**CEASE AND DESIST ORDER**

8 The above-captioned matter came before the Arizona State Board of Behavioral Health  
9 Examiners (“Board”) on October 14, 2022, for the purposes of determining whether grounds  
10 existed to issue a Cease and Desist Order to Dondra Lafrance Campbell (“Respondent”).  
11 Respondent was properly noticed of the Board’s review of this issue, but did not appear.

12 **FACTS REVIEWED**

- 13 1. Respondent has never been certified/licensed by the Board.
- 14 2. On 09/02/22, a complaint was submitted against Respondent alleging the  
15 following:
- 16 a. On 08/10/22, Respondent submitted a counseling referral for a client to their  
17 clinic, stating the client was one of his students.
- 18 b. At the bottom of the referral, Respondent identified himself as “MC, LPC.”
- 19 c. There is no public record showing Respondent is an LPC and there is concern  
20 he is misrepresenting himself.
- 21
- 22 3. Due to Respondent not being licensed, no complaint was opened.
- 23 4. On 09/16/22, Respondent was notified via mail of the allegations and a response  
24 to questions from Board staff was requested, but to date, no response has been received.
- 25 5. On 09/19/22, a social worker with Respondent’s employer (“School”) reached out  
26 to Board staff with concerns regarding Respondent.



**RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW**

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.03 and § 32-3284(A), Respondent has the right to obtain an administrative hearing in this matter by submitting a written request to the Board. The Board must receive the request at its office within thirty (30) days after service of this Order. A.R.S. § 41-1092.03(B). Service of this order is effective five (5) days after date of mailing. The request must contain a concise statement of the reasons for the hearing. If Respondent requests a hearing, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.06, Respondent has the additional right to request that the Board conduct an informal settlement conference. To request an informal settlement conference, Respondent must submit a written request to the Board no later than 20 days before the hearing that may be scheduled in this matter. If a motion for rehearing is not filed, the Board's Order becomes effective thirty-five (35) days after it is mailed to Respondent.

Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing is required to preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
